2012 Acton Chinese Music Night Performance December 2nd at Acton-Boxborough Regional High School

Come & See the Wondrous Sights & Sounds of China

Acton, MA (November 3, 2012) --- More than 100 performers will be featured in a night of colorful Chinese music and dance on Sunday, December 2, 2012 from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. at the Acton-Boxborough Regional High School auditorium in Acton, Massachusetts.

This "2012 Acton Chinese Music Night" will showcase various aspects of ancient Chinese culture and ethnic groups through modern dance and music performances designed to transport your eyes and ears into the wondrous sights and sounds of China.

Talented performers from the Angel Dance Company will dominate all aspects of the event with colorful dance and music celebrations in the theme of "Beauty of the Descendants of the Dragon."

In addition, the show will feature performances by guzheng (Chinese plucked stringed musical instrument) artist Hui Weng and award winning dancer Yufeng Liu.

This event is jointly presented by the Acton Chinese Language School (ACLS), the Angel Dance Company, the Town of Acton Recreation Commission, and the Acton-Boxborough Cultural Council.

“The communities in the Acton and Boxborough area and neighboring towns encompass diverse culture, heritage and traditions,” said Ms. Yanni Gou, Chair of the ACLS Board of Directors. “This Chinese Music Night gives everyone in our local area an opportunity to learn about Chinese culture, and to experience the historical origins of the Chinese nation through music and dance.

“ACLS successfully hosted Acton Chinese Music Night in 2006, 2007 and 2009, and we’re pleased to offer it again this year. It is through activities such as this that we can show our Chinese community’s support and participation in the mainstream society, and we invite all the families here in Acton and surrounding towns to join us for this special night,” Ms. Gou added.
